

NTC indicative stakeholder engagement schedule September 2018 – March 2019

The table below classifies the types of stakeholder engagement and the indicative schedule planned to occur for projects on the NTC’s work program 2018–19.

There are generally four phases of the stakeholder engagement cycle:

1. **Exploratory phase (preliminary scoping)** – to define or refine issues or approaches
2. **Deliberative phase (public engagement)** – to consider stakeholder views on a range of feasible policy options/issues for recommending those options which have positive net benefit
3. **Refinement phase (targeted engagement and engagement with government entities)** – to seek views on/refine how policy decisions can be implemented. This may be with a range of stakeholders or the implementation authorities only
4. **Educative phase (information sharing)** – to ensure that there is a consistent understanding and application of issues being implemented.

Colour code

	Preliminary scoping – targeted informal engagement before issuing a discussion or issues paper to confirm issues or accuracy of information
	Public engagement – submission responses to set questions seeking detailed feedback before decision has been made
	Targeted engagement – informal responses to ensure actions/proposal is consistent with agreed policy decision and/or to assess implementation issues
	Engagement with government entities (e.g. jurisdictions or regulators) only – to seek views on implementation/workability of policy decisions
